Door County in the Fall & Cranberry Marsh

October 13-17, 2015

Call soon—Last chance to sign up for this trip

We have space for a few more to go with us to Door County Wisconsin October 13-17. On our way to Door County we will stop and tour the House on The Rock in Spring Green, Wisconsin. The first night we will stop in the Green Bay Wisconsin area.

We will get to Sturgeon Bay mid morning on the 14th where we will visit the Maritime Museum. We will stop in Fish Creek where you will have lunch on your own and have a little free time. After lunch we will make a photo stop at the historic Eagle Bluff Lighthouse built in 1868 and drive through the Peninsula State Park. We will arrive at the waterfront Rowley's Bay Resort in the afternoon which will be our home for the next 2 nights. The first night at the resort, we will have a fish boil dinner buffet. In addition to fish, the buffet will include chicken, meatballs, various side dishes. There's a 14ft salad, bakery and dessert bar so no one will leave hungry. Each morning we will have a Breakfast Buffet at the resort.

On the 15th we will go to Northport and will take a ferry to Washington Island where we will take a tour of the Island and have lunch. The evening of the 15th we will have dinner at Al Johnson Swedish Restaurant & Butik. This is not your normal restaurant. They have goats grazing on their roof. After dinner we will enjoy a program put on by the Peninsula Players before returning to the resort.

The morning of the 16th we will leave Door County and head to Warrens, WI. We will stop at the Wisconsin Cranberry Discovery Center and visit a Cranberry Marsh. Late September and October is Cranberry harvest season.

We will continue traveling home October 17th and should arrive in central Iowa late afternoon or early evening.

This trip includes all activities listed above, Motorcoach transportation, 4 nights lodging, Luggage handling, 8 Meals (4 breakfasts, 1 lunch, 3 dinners), taxes and gratuities. Barn & Farm Tour—September 19th

We will visit a few barns going and coming from the Tyden Farm No. 6

At the Tyden Farm we will see: The man with the plan! In the twentieth Century, a Swedish immigrant came to this country with \$20 to his name. Col. Emil Tyden played a big part in our agricultural and manufacturing past and present. Tyden developed the Cargo Seal, which has been keeping our train and cargo safe and secure. He also helped enhance sprinkler systems. Tyden built eight farms in North Central Iowa, all in the time of the Great Depression. The Big red Barn! One of the highlights of our tour is viewing this massive barn. The barn was built in 1936 and is still standing tall and proud at 140 x 40 feet. You will see old farm machinery and horse drawn machinery. The Corn Crib! Standing around 60 feet tall and made of concrete block. Enjoy the farm family museum with a pictorial tour of the Sears house and furnishings. Don't forget to stop by the summer kitchen to get a look at what early cooking was like. Around the farm are several beautiful gardens. Enjoy this day which includes two coffee times and a farm meal at noon. This trip is just a couple weeks away. Make reservations NOW. Cost is \$96.
