Day 1: Saturday, July 25

As we fly in to Anchorage we will see the Chugach Mountains and the Cook Inlet surrounding Anchorage. After checking into our hotel we will meet our Journey Host and learn about our upcoming adventure.

Day 2: Sunday, July 26

We will board the McKinley Explorer and enjoy a scenic train ride to Denali. The evening will be yours to explore the community on your own.

**Day 3: Monday, July 27**

We will venture into Denali on the Tundra Wilderness Tour. The renowned **Denali Tundra Wilderness Tour** will take you up to 30 miles deep into the park, increasing your odds of seeing wildlife and the Great One—Mt. McKinley. On this fully narrated 8 hour tour, you'll benefit from your driver's years of experience and you'll also get up close views of wildlife with the drop-down screen on your bus. The tour includes a box snack lunch and frequent stops.

Day 4: Tuesday, July 28

Explore on your own or take optional excursions with an entire day in Denali. If you wish, you could choose to attend a dinner theatre at the McKinley Chalet Resort.

Day 5: Wednesday, July 29

We will make our way to Fairbanks the "Golden Heart City". Learn how to pan for gold at the Gold Dredge No. 8. Fairbanks is located on the broad Tanana River plain between the White Mountains and the Alaska Range.

Day 6: Thursday, July 30

We will have a short flight to Dawson City. In the summer of 1896, huge quantities of gold was found. Dawson is a National Historic Site that has turned back the clock to preserve a rich living history. Meander the wooden boardwalks with costumed townsfolk ready to share their home and its national historic treasures.

Day 7: Friday, July 31

Enjoy a nostalgic Yukon River paddle wheeler cruise aboard the Klondike Spirit.

**Day 8: Saturday, August 1**

We will take a motor coach to Whitehorse. Whitehorse is where thousands of Stampeders traveled down the Yukon River to Dawson. Lunch will be in historic Minto.

Day 9: Sunday, August 2

Motorcoach ride to Fraser then board the White Pass & Yukon Railroad to Skagway. Some of the aspiring Klondike gold rushers who made it to Skagway took a look at the 500-mile journey that was ahead of them and decided to stop.

Day 10: Monday, August 3

A full day to experience colorful Skagway. Choose from many optional excursions or simply relax

Day 11: Tuesday , August 4

Bid farewell to our Journey Host and embark the Holland America’s ms Noordam Ship.

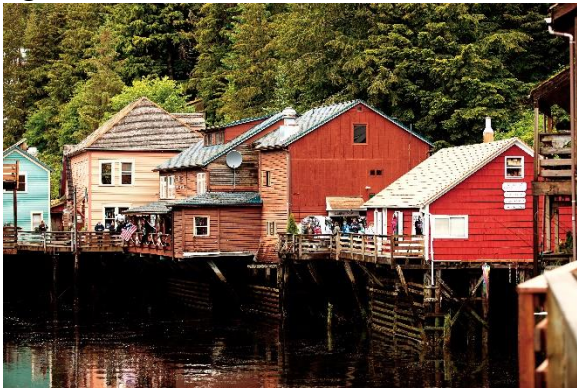
Day 12: Wednesday, August 5
